

How long are the cases in this book?

Cases vary in length and complexity. Depending on depth of analysis and time available for out-of-class preparation, most cases can be analyzed in two hours, or less. A few cases are short and have one issue. Most, however, are integrative and complex and involve multiple problems and issues.

This text includes tables and figures to enhance learning. Additionally, the book provides exercises and role-plays of different management scenarios to dissect, interpret, and try to resolve by applying knowledge, skills, and expertise from all areas of healthcare administration.
